DESCRIPTION

Theoretical and practical classes in Fashion Make-up/Avant Garde make-up.

Make-up techniques that will be used for fashion shoots, runway shows, theatrical productions and other arts.

WHEN?

All classes are presented on Saturday, one Saturday per month for four months, commencing on **25 February, 11 March, 22 April, 7 May 2022** from **09:00 – 14:00** at North West School of Design.

Students, will be allocated a model to work on for their final class, where the assessment of knowledge will be verified by the lecturer.

Students will also have the opportunity to partake in a fashion shoot, whereby they will make-up the models for the shoot and the North West School of Design photography students will be in charge of the photoshoot.

Fashion make-up students will also assist at the Platinum Fashion Festival of NWSD, to assist backstage with the make-up of the models for the Platinum Fashion Festival for further exposure and knowledge.

Lastly certificates will be issued to students once they have successfully completed the course.

Short Courses

Here at North West School of Design, our short courses are a combination of evening classes and Saturday workshops ranging from one -day workshops to two month part-time courses.

In the efforts to make our short course more affordable, the NWSD short courses are offered as non-accredited bearing courses, as these courses are not unit standard based. Student therefore receive a non-accredited bearing certificate after completing the short course.

What Does It Mean If My Course Is Non-Accredited?

Are you interested in studying a non-accredited course, but not sure whether it is worth the time and money? Many people are still under the impression that a non-accredited course has no value.
