## **WHAT DO I NEED ?**

### **What YOU need to provide:**

- Pen and Pencil
- Notebook
- Measuring Tape
- Clothes Pins
- Fabric Scissor
- Own sewing machine

Students will need a notebook to write down additional information as needed.

As this is a non-credit bearing course, there are no strict requirements to complete the course.

Although the ability to read and write, as well as basic math skills are important factors that the prospective student must possess. The minimum age to register is 17 (Seventeen) years with the assistance of a Guardian or Parent in registering.
