Pins, Measuring tape, Top Fabric (2,5 - 3 metres),
Lining (+- 2 metres), Fusing (available from NWSD)
Shoulder pads, Buttons, Thread and
polycotton for the pocketing.
1 m calico, and +- 50cm batting.

Trousers:

1 x Shop bought pattern (trousers)
Tracing paper
Paper Scissor and Fabric Scissor
2 - 3m Fabric
Polycotton for pocketing
Waist banding (+- 2m)
Trousers hook and eye or
Trousers buttons
Trousers zip 20 cm

Short Courses

Here at North West School of Design, our short courses are a combination of evening classes and Saturday workshops ranging from one –day workshops to two month part-time courses.

In the efforts to make our short course more affordable, the NWSD short courses are offered as non-credit bearing courses, as these courses are not unit standard based. Student therefore receive a non-credit bearing certificate after completing the short course.

What Does It Mean If My Course Is Non-Accredited?
