Various sewing examples will be demonstrated by lecturer, whereby students will have to produce skirt, blouse and samples which includes all the required sewing techniques.

After the course has been completed, the student will then have the ability to design their own range and put their skills to use by designing for clients or working at a boutique.

- \*\* Students will need a notebook and pen, an eraser and a ruler to take down additional notes during class.

As this is a non-credit bearing course, there are no strict requirements to study **Part Time Sewing**. Although the ability to read and write, as well as basic math skills are important factors that the prospective student must possess. The minimum age to register is 17 (Seventeen) years with the assistance of a Guardian or Parent in registering.
