WORKSHOP OPTIONS

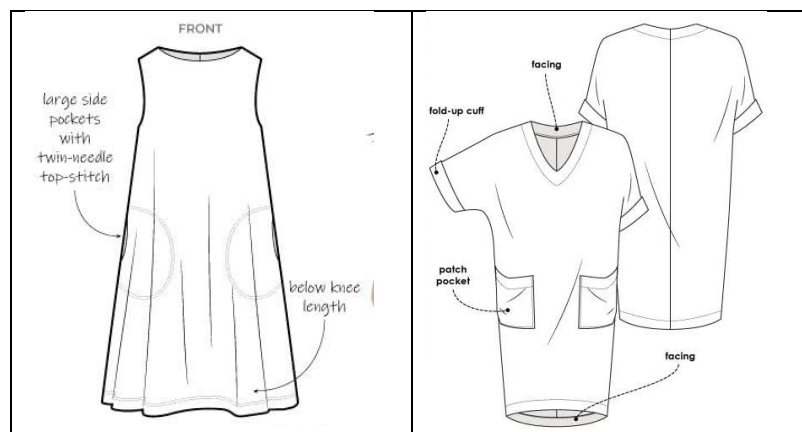
1. Option 1: Sew Your Own Kimono

CERTIFICATION

Here at North West School of Design, our short courses are a combination of evening classes and workshops ranging from one -day workshops to nine-month part-time courses.

In the efforts to make our short course more affordable, the NWSD short courses are offered as non-credit bearing courses, as these courses are not unit standard based.

Student therefore receive a non-credit bearing certificate after completing the short course.
